The course is designed to help students grasp the complexity of our current environmental and socio-economic sustainability situation, and its opportunities and limitations for the modern corporate enterprise.

- Examine how private sector activity impacts societal and ecological sustainability, using perspectives from diverse backgrounds.

- Explore how government regulations, voluntary standards, and the financial sector metrics impact business and sustainability.
- Understand the drivers of sustainability as both threats and opportunities for the private sector.
