EVPP 429/529 Environmental Science Communication



This course will explore the ways in which communication processes affect proenvironmental behavior and how environmental science is conducted, reported, interpreted, and used by decision-makers.

Students may choose to explore either the practical or social science dimensions of environmental communication in their classwork, though all will be expected to read social science literature.
