Litchfield Undergraduate Research in Environmental Microbiology Endowed Scholarship

Purpose

The Litchfield Scholarship will be awarded for one year at GMU, for a full-time, in-state, or outof-state undergraduate student who qualifies based on a research proposal in environmental microbiology.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be enrolled in an undergraduate program at GMU
- Must have maintained a GPA of 3.0 or higher

Award Funding

- Up to a maximum of \$10,000 research budget
- \$10,000 student stipend (\$5,400 during the academic year and \$3,600 during summer term)
- Tuition waiver of up to 30 tuition credits at the in-state rate (up to 15 credits in Fall and 15 credits in Spring semesters) at the university's rate during the scholarship's term.

Application Process
