
Overview

George Mason University VPN allows you to connect to Mason networks as if you were on campus, making access to restricted services possible. To connect to the MESA drive from your Mac, you need to map the drive.

Mapping MESA on a Mac


- 1. Connect to the VPN using the Cisco AnyConnect Client.
- 2. From the **Finder**, go to the **Go Menu > Connect to Server**.



3. The Connect to Server dialog box will appear.



4. If you have already saved your MESA drive, you can click on it and click **Connect**. Otherwise, in the **Server Address** box, type **smb://mesa2.mesa.gmu.edu/NetID** (replace "NetID" with your Patriot Pass NetID).



5. Click the + button to save the server.



- 6. Click Connect.
- 7. The credentials are your Patriot Pass NetID and password.



8. Click **Connect** to open your Mesa Drive.
