The Math Placement Test is required to register for Math 105, 108, 123, 125 and 113 unless prerequisites are met using alternative college credit.

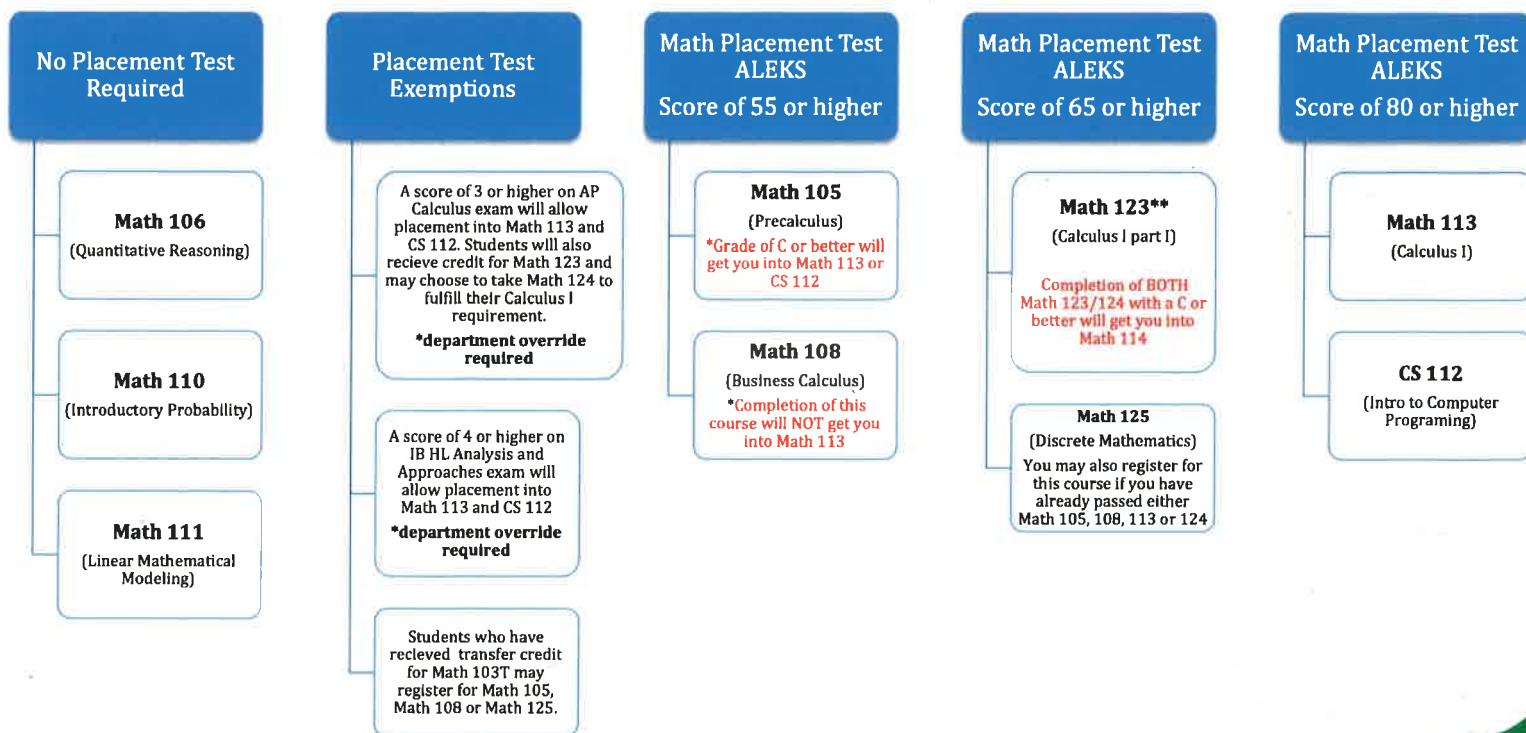

I took the test, what do my scores mean?

This flow chart shows the prerequisites required for 100-level math courses.



**Students who take both Math 123 and Math 124 are given credit that is equivalent to Math 113. This is a year long Calculus I sequence and after the student gets a C or better in Math 124 they are eligible to take Math 114.

Students must first take or have credit for Math 123 before taking Math 124.
