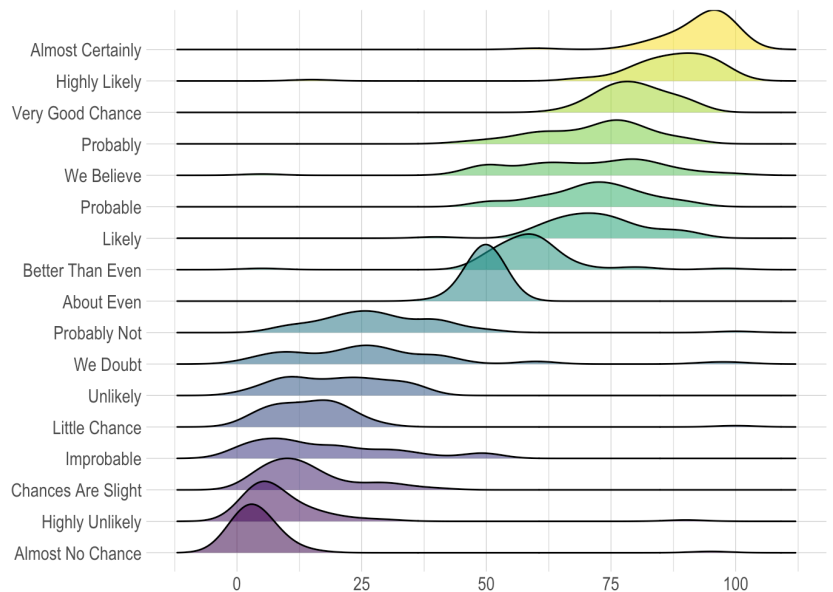

This class aims to teach students the basic concepts, skills, and tools for working with and analyzing data using R. This is an introduction course to R and is designed for students with little to no programming experience. Students will learn about R syntax, the RStudio interface, and how to manage and manipulate data starting with a CSV file and ending with graphing results from an analysis. This course will use examples from both the natural and social sciences. No background in computing is required.
