Purpose

To help students from developing nations, who need financial assistance, to come from their foreign country of residence to pursue either an MS or PhD degree in the Environmental Science and Policy Department. The recipient must intend to pursue a degree in conservation biology or a degree that combines environmental policy to seek solutions to environmental problems.

Eligibility Criteria

- Applicants must be enrolled in (or have applied to) the Environmental Science and Policy Master's program or the Environmental Science and Public Policy Doctoral Program.
