- 1. Official documentation of Undergraduate degree
- 2. If applicable, official evaluation of international transcripts
- 3. If required by department, official documentation of Master's degree

NOTES

- **999 Registration deadline:** Students must be advanced to candidacy by the advancement semester's add deadline in order to register for 999 that semester. If the add deadline has passed, students must wait until the following semester to register for 999.
- Students working on dissertation research (999) must register for a minimum of 3 credits of 999 in their first semester (excluding summers). After that semester, they must register for 1 credit of 999 until the dissertation is complete and has been officially submitted to the library.
- Non-Course Requirements worksheet, page 2, must be completed at time of Advancement to Candidacy. Please list all exams, portfolios, proficiencies or other requirements for candidacy that are required by your program.
